

TELECOMMUNICATION DEVICES FOR THE DEAF (TDD) FLORIDA RELAY SERVICE/RELAY 7-1-1

Trained operators relay messages between hearing and speech-impaired persons using Telecommunication Devices for the Deaf (TDD) and those who do not have access to such a device. In recent years, many public and private entities have opted to use this service rather than maintain a TDD in their offices. The Relay is available statewide, 24 hours/day.
