In Alachua County there are a number of mental health services including the county Crisis Center, the Gainesville Peer Respite house, the University of Florida Counseling and Wellness Center for UF students, and Meridian. These organizations offer different types of help. There are crisis lines for suicidal cases, "warm" lines for venting and general information lines.

Unfortunately, some are not a 24/7 service. UF students are often put on a waiting list to get counseling on campus. However, there is a 24/7 service and it is to dial 211.
