ReadingPal FAQs

01

Will ReadingPals be virtual or in-person this school year?

ReadingPals will be virtual using the Vello online platform funded by the statewide ReadingPals grant. In-person volunteering is suspended until further notice.

How can volunteers sign up to volunteer as a ReadingPal?

Volunteers can complete the volunteer application using the link on our webpage at www.readingpalsgnv.org.

How will students connect to their ReadingPal session?

Students can connect to their ReadingPal session using the Vello app from a tablet, Chromebook, laptop or desktop computer.

When will ReadingPals start?

The official statewide virtual launch date is October 5th 2020. We are currently accepting applications for volunteers at the link on our website at www.readingpalsgnv.org

Will students still receive book packs?

Our goal is to provide at least 1 take-home book to students each month, in addition to usual bookpacks. These books will be provided to the partnering sites and the site staff will facilitate distribution to students.

Who can volunteer as a ReadingPal?

At this time we are accepting volunteers ages 15 years and older.

07

How long are ReadingPal sessions?

Each ReadingPal session will be 30-45 minutes long. Volunteers have the option to volunteer more than once per week. Volunteer commitments are Fall through May 2021 or January 2021-May 2021.

Which grades do we work with?

To be matched with a ReadingPal, students must be in 1st, 2nd or 3rd grade. In some cases, we will match a kindergarten student with a ReadingPal.
